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I. Discover + Adopt Program Overview

The Centre for Aging + Brain Health Innovation (CABHI)'s Discover and Adopt (D+A) program aims to support Canadian-based care delivery organizations (specifically, long term care homes, retirement homes, hospitals, etc. that provide care to older adults) with funding and training to build the skills and capacity required to introduce, implement, and sustain innovations in their own settings.

CABHI recognizes that organizations face many barriers to sourcing, testing, and adopting innovations (e.g., products, programs, or services) that can improve the quality of care and quality of life of those they serve.

Participating **organizations** gain access to:

- Dedicated funding to allocate staff and resources to work on an innovation project
- Learning series and coaching support from CABHI on how to plan for implementation
- Practical experience with small tests of change, with the opportunity to use their learnings for broader scale adoption

Participating **innovators** gain access to:

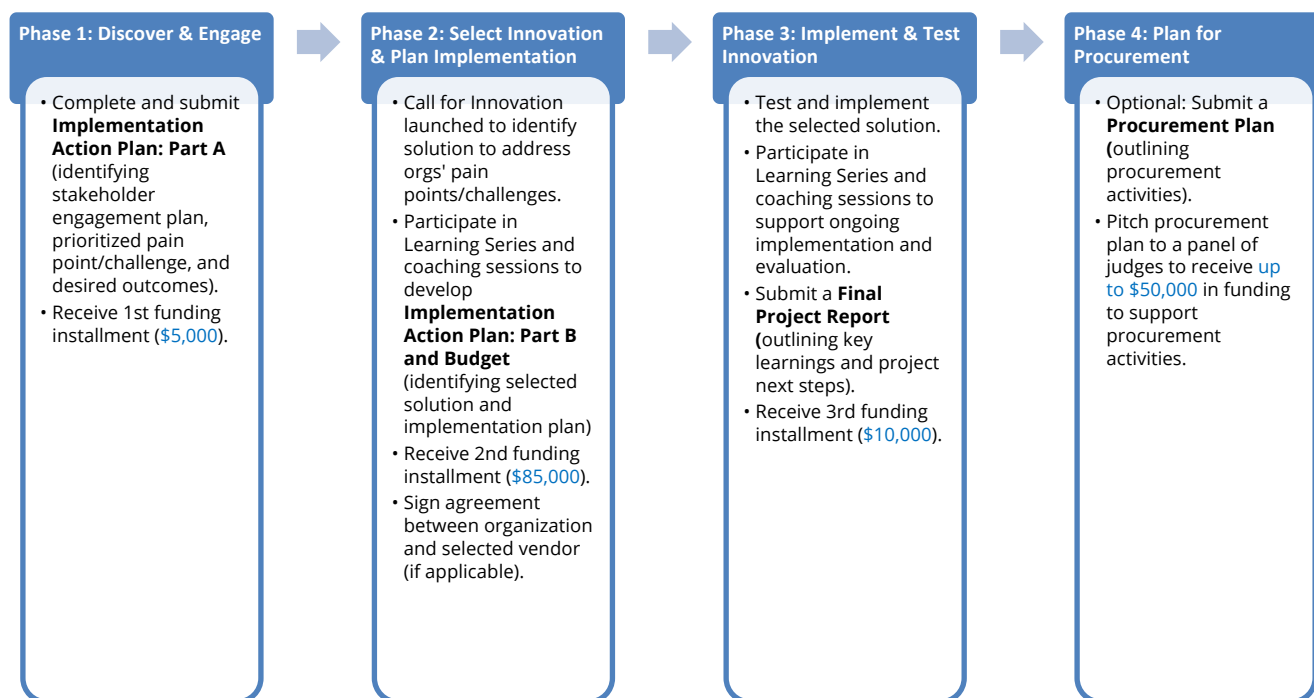
- Use case scenarios and potential testimonials on how their solution can be used by different users in different settings
- End-user feedback to further refine their solution for better product-market fit
- Potential customers

II. Discover + Adopt Program Phases

Participating organizations will be engaged through four phases of activities (See Figure 1).

- 1) Phase 1: Discover & Engage
- 2) Phase 2: Select Innovation & Plan Implementation
- 3) Phase 3: Implement & Test Innovation
- 4) Phase 4: Procurement

III. Important Dates

Program applications open	May 29, 2023
Application deadline	June 30, 2023
Shortlist interviews and selection	July 3 – August 21, 2023
Selected applicants notified	August 22, 2023

IV. CABHI Investment

Each participating organization will receive \$100,000 CAD to achieve implementation milestones over 12 months. Organizations that make a procurement decision will have the option of submitting a procurement plan and pitching their plan to a panel of judges to receive up to \$50,000 CAD in support of procurement activities.

CABHI's investment will support backfilling of key staff members who will be participating in the D+A program activities and overseeing management and completion of program milestones and deliverables (See Figure 1). CABHI will engage with each participating organization to confirm eligible expenses, payment schedule, and cash flow.

IV. Application Process

- 1) **Online applications:** Applications are submitted online and then reviewed for eligibility.
- 2) **Shortlist selection:** Shortlisted applicants will be invited to participate in a virtual interview with CABHI's review panel.
- 3) **Program start:** Selected applicants/organizations will be notified by CABHI and invited to participate in the program. CABHI will proceed with contracting of program funding prior to program start.

V. Application Assessment Criteria

Application Forms will be assessed based on the following criteria:

- 1) Completeness of application form
- 2) Organization eligibility (Canadian-based care delivery organizations including long term care homes, retirement homes, hospitals, etc. that provide care to older adults)
- 3) Located in Canada
- 4) Preliminary experience with introducing an innovative product, program, service
- 5) Availability of staff members to participate in program activities
- 6) Leadership Support for application

VI. Notification of Application Status

Successful applicants will be notified by email and receive instructions on program activities, schedule, and resources.

VII. Learning Series and Coaching Sessions

Participating organizations will attend the D+A Learning Series and participate in several coaching sessions throughout the duration of the program.

The coaching sessions will provide practical guidance and tools to support each organization with moving through program phases, from conducting a needs assessment, creating a challenge brief, selecting an innovation, to developing and operationalizing an implementation action plan and monitoring process. Each organization will be expected to have the same team members join the coaching sessions to review and provide feedback on their milestones and deliverables.
